COMPLETE DENTURE



- A complete denture is a removable appliance used when all teeth within a jaw have been lost and need to be prosthetically replaced
- 2. A complete denture is constructed when there are no more teeth left in an arch.

REMOVABLE PARTIAL DENTURE



- Removable Partial dentures are usually removable dentures that replace multiple teeth in the upper or lower portion of your mouth.
- 2. A prosthesis that replaces one or more, but not all of the natural teeth and supporting structures. It is supported by the teeth and/or the mucosa.

FIXED PARTIAL DENTURE



- 1. Partial dentures are used when one or more natural teeth remain in the upper or lower jaw.
- 2. A **fixed bridge** replaces one or more teeth by placing crowns on the teeth on either side of the space and attaching artificial teeth to them. This "bridge" is then cemented into place.

DENTAL IMPLANTS



- 1. A dental implant (artificial tooth root) is a popular tooth replacement option, Implants are surgically implanted into your jawbone, mirror the shape of a screw, and bond with the natural bone.
- 2. Dental implants look and feel like your own teeth. And because they are designed to fuse with bone, they become permanent.

FACIAL PROSTHESIS



- 1. A facial prosthetic or facial prosthesis is an artificial device used to change or adapt the outward appearance of a person's face or head.
- **2.**A **facial prosthesis** is an artificial replacement of an eye, ear, nose or other portion of the **face** that restores normal appearance may improve function
